- 2. There are 4 groups that have vacancies:
 - a) CNPA Representative on COAT Board COAT is a Scottish charity which delivers work to enhance outdoor access. Its work has grown from the initial focus on the Cairngorms National Park and now includes work in both National Parks and elsewhere. CNPA is a member of COAT and nominates a Director to the Trust. For the purposes of charity law the Directors are deemed to be Trustees.
 - b) CNPA Representative on Cairngorms Community Broadband Company The draft functions to carry out activities which benefit the community and in particular:
 - Improve digital connectivity, particularly, but not limited to, rural areas including in the Cairngorms National Park and surrounding areas.
 - Improve physical infrastructure through the provision of a reliable, fast broadband and telecommunications service which is financially sustainable, to residential and private, public, community and voluntary and business customers in and in the vicinity of the Cairngorms National Park.
 - To develop, install, manage and maintain broadband access and communication services for households and businesses based in and in the vicinity of the Cairngorms National park.
 - Provide support and access to skills and equipment to enable clients to access digital connectivity.
 - To support learning and education and ICT skills development for people of all ages in the community.
 - Encourage members of the community to participate in voluntary activity in pursuit of the company's objects and/or where there is public benefit
 - Assist voluntary organisations, charities and social enterprises through sponsorship, equipment, training and development of their online presence and participation.

This is a new Group and it is likely that there will be a significant time commitment in the first 12 - 18 months beyond the formal meetings.

- c) CNPA Board Observer to attend VisitAberdeenshire Board meetings on a quarterly basis.
- d) Gordon Riddler has stepped down as a member of the Audit & Risk Committee and as Convener of the Group. A member is requested to join the group and at its next meeting the Committee will select its new Convener.
- 3. We are seeking a nomination to attend each of these Groups on behalf of the Board.
