





Preferred Site Options

Allocate THC070 for 4 houses


Our assessment of alternative site options can be found in the Site Assessment Report published alongside the Main Issues Report DULNAIN BRIDGE is a small village situated to the west of Grantown-on-Spey. The village has a garage, shop and community hall and is well served for its size. Some growth is necessary to sustain the village and future development should complement the sensitive woodland setting of the village, enhance its character and support tourism.

Issues for Dulnain Bridge

- Provision and delivery of affordable housing, particularly opportunities for community-owned housing
- Diversifying the local economy
- Connecting cycle paths from Dulnain Bridge to Grantown-on-Spey and Carr-Bridge

Proposed settlement objectives

- Support the delivery of housing that meets local needs, particularly affordable housing
- Support proposals to enhance and diversify the local economy and the role of tourism
- Support proposals for safe active travel around Dulnain Bridge and beyond to Grantown-on-Spey and Carr-Bridge
