Preferred Sites: Yes, though less keen on H1, due to large allocated number and impacts on the surrounding woodland from increased recreation use.

Protected Open Spaces 1 / Proposed settlement boundary: I am concerned about the removal of the area of land to the north of the river in the vicinity of grid ref NH 90131 22979 currently used for livestock, concerned that it gives impression of having lost some protected open area status and it's omission from the settlement boundary.

Protected Open Spaces 2: I am also concerned about the removal of a small field within the village at grid ref NH 90680 22749, that is occasionally used for livestock. It is currently a pleasant green area along the main street through the village and it would be disappointing to see it built on at some point in the future, it has the impression of having lost protected open space status.

Alternative Site Options: THC057, I feel would be a poor extension to the settlement boundary and detrimental to be approach from Aviemore. It could also impact on areas currently fairly inaccessible from the existing path network. Development of this site could increase disturbance to wildlife.

Alternative Site Options 2: THC066, I feel would be a challenging sloping site with potential issues for run-off onto the main road.

Connecting cycle paths to Aviemore: I would fully support an offroad link joining with the Speyside Way to aid tourism and cycle commuting between the settlements. There is currently a track over the hill via Docharn Cottage, however the track surface is a quagmire due to livestock and not great for cycle commuting.
