I am objecting to the area being zoned for commercial development. This is a large area of forestry which is used extensively by locals and visitors for recreation. Footpaths run across the site and the removal of this area would have a negative impact on the community.

I also object as a member of the Carrbridge Capercaillie Group. I and a friend saw a female capercaillie in the newly clearfelled area of this area just three weeks ago. The Capercaillie habitat is already under threat and the zoning of more forestry will have a negative impact due to potential removal of trees and disturbance by additional commercial operations.

I understand the need for Landmark to have more car parking spaces and have no problem with a small area being zoned off for this purpose. However, the zoning of an area which is double the size of the existing development is detrimental to the community.
