As an owner of property at Lochan Mor I wish to add my voice to that expressed by Ross and Liddell concerning the proposal for the new community site at Lochan Mor.

I realise this letter is being sent after the 21st September deadline but given the gravity of the situation I hope you will give it due consideration. My attention has only recently been drawn to this matter.

The area of concern is an open space used by many people, especially children, for a safe environment in which to play. To remove this would result in the loss of a facility which encourages residents and visitors, especially the young who might otherwise be cooped up in their homes, to be outdoors at any time of year. There is already limited open space like this for Aviemore residents.

Aviemore already has buildings which serve well as locations for indoor, organised activities and clubs.

I would urge the CNPA to remember the original purpose of this land and let it remain as an open area for the benefit of local residents.
