Badenoch

Badenoch is first recorded as a place name from the 13th century and derives from the Gaelic Bàideanach, meaning the drowned land – a reference to the seasonal flooding of the Spev River and the extensive upland flood plain of the Insh Marshes. Today Badenoch is part of the Cairngorms National Park.
